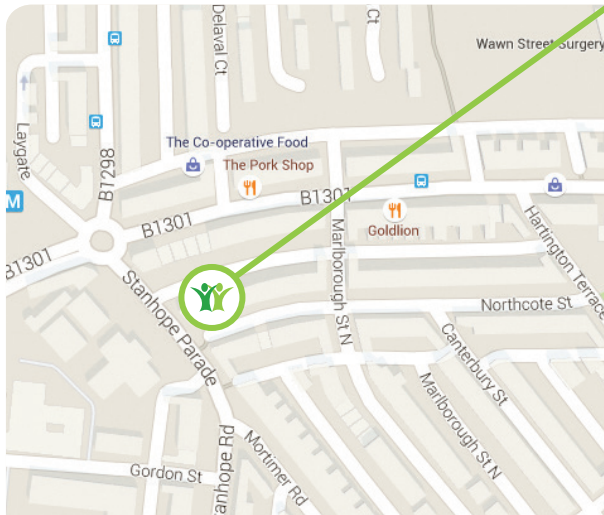

Directions

From South Shields – head south-west on Dale Street and turn right onto Woodbine Street. Turn left onto Ocean Road/A183 and you will then come across a series of roundabouts:

1st roundabout – go straight on, 2nd roundabout – take the 3rd exit onto Beach Road/A183 and then turn right onto Crossgate/A194. 3rd roundabout – take the 2nd exit onto Western Approach/A194, 4th roundabout – take the 2nd exit again for Western Approach, 5th roundabout – take the 1st exit onto Laygate/B1301. At the 6th roundabout – take the 1st exit onto Dean Road/B1301 followed by the 4th exit on the next roundabout to Stanhope Parade/B1298 and Ashlea Mews will be on the left.
