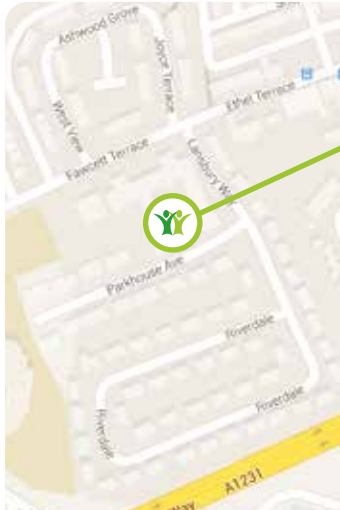

From A19 – exit the A19 onto the A1231, follow the road to the BP garage on the left, turn left at that roundabout then turn right at the next mini roundabout and we are on the right hand side.

From town centre (driving) – head towards and over Queen Alexandra Bridge along A1231 and head towards A19, at 3rd roundabout (BP garage on the right) take 3rd exit, then turn right at the next mini roundabout and we are on the right hand side.

From town centre (bus) – local buses that bring you to Lansbury Court are the 35 and 36 and both stop on the main street outside of Lansbury Court.
